Manchester Town Hall: The Manchester Town Hall was built from 1868 to 1877 in a neo-Gothic architectural style. The tower of the Town Hall is 85 meters high.



Manchester Art Gallery: The Manchester Art Gallery is a museum in the city. It is arranged in three interconnected buildings. The collection includes more than 2000 paintings, 3000 watercolours and drawings, 250 sculptures and nearly 1000 graphic reproductions. The exhibits are basically from European artists from baroque to present.



Manchester Opera House: The Manchester Opera House was opened 1912. There are opera, ballet and musical performances. And there are 1920 seats for the audience. 1958, in the Manchester Opera House was the European premiere of the musical "West Side Story".
