- Government of Scotland
- Scotland has limited self-government
- -The UK Parliament retains control over (specified in the Scotland Act 1998):
 - -taxes
 - -social security
 - -defence
 - -international relations
 - -broadcasting

- History
- -The Kingdom of Scotland became an independent state
 - → the Early Middle Ages
 - → continued to exist until 1707
- By inheritance in 1603, James VI(King of Scots) became King of England and King of Ireland
 - → formed a personal union of the three Kingdoms
- -Scotland entered into a political union with the Kingdom of England
 - → 1 May 1707
 - → to create the new Kingdom of Great Britain
